A core part of our mission is to provide students with the instruction and life skills necessary to succeed at the college or the university of their choice and to prepare them to embark on a career that they are passionate about pursuing!

- Robust college planning supports provided throughout your WISH Academy experience
- College preparatory courses, AP courses, Honors courses, and Dual Enrollment courses are offered to ensure all students have access to a myriad of ways of meeting their goals.
- Beginning in 9th grade students have support, instruction, and guidance in preparing for college and understand the self-discipline needed to succeed in meeting their personal goals
- Each semester students meet with their guidance counselor to ensure they are meeting their targets
- Parent and caregiver meetings are held in a small group format, with WISH students and the academic guidance counselor, for each grade level, each semester to ensure students are able to have full access and support to the myriad of opportunities leading up to and while applying for colleges
- All students have a private portal beginning in 9th grade that hosts their transcripts, letters of recommendation, courses completed, essays, and personalized action plan to guide them through the necessary steps to apply for college
- Monthly both, in person (when permitted) and virtual college tours are held for prominent local, state, national, and international colleges and universities, college and university representatives come to campus to do outreach to students directly, and students attend local college fairs
- All 12th grade students have a dedicated class to support them in completing their college applications, writing their essays, submitting their FASFA, obtaining letters of recommendation, and to provide the guidance necessary to successfully apply to each of their targeted colleges or universities
