



GOAL Tutoring Program (Great Opportunity to Achieve Learning)

WISH Middle students are encouraged to participate in the after school GOAL program. This tutoring program is for students who would like a quiet place to complete homework, study for assessments, and get additional academic and organizational assistance. GOAL is from 3:25-4:30 every Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday and from 2:15-3:15 on Thursdays. Students may work on any homework or classwork from all subjects at any time. Lions for Learning LMU tutors are also available during this time to tutor students individually by teacher/parent request or as needed.

GOAL Expectations:

- Students attending GOAL should line up outside of the assigned classrooms at 3:25
- Sign-in and find a personal space to work
- Take out Agenda book and any additional homework materials
- Voices should be kept at a 0-1 level throughout the hour
- Students may write their name on the whiteboard under the subject they would like assistance in
- Students should be working on academic homework and/or skills the entire time at GOAL
- Do your best and ask for help when needed
